## INTRODUCTION

The third session was opened with a moderated caucus after an order list. Consequently, delegates main aim in this last session was to successfully address the possible solution towards topic b, refugee minors without education in their displaced country. For this, delegates began negotiating the solution that were addressed in the second session the previous day.

## DEVELOPMENT OF THE MODEL

Therefore, delegates such as Spain highlighted the importance of considering factors such as language barriers, racism and xenophobia while addressing how to improve the educational system for refugee children. Moreover, the delegate of Belgium claimed that the formation of NGOs wasn't a proper solution and instead using resources like UNESCO will expand better education, this idea was supported by other delegations such as Greece, US, Spain and Poland. Moreover, the delegate of Greece proposed the idea of investing in the funding of global education in countries with low economical sources like Congo and Syria. After this, a lobby time was approved by the chair and delegates got reunited to discuss solutions for the working papers. Russia, China and other delegations were working in a press release since they didn't totally agree with the other solutions or weren't allied with the other delegations. On the other hand, the other delegations that were able to construct a block such as Poland, Belgium, Brazil, Egypt and Mexico were working in a working paper to propose their final solutions. The lobby time was extended for 15 minutes.



## CLOSURE

After the lobby time ended, a round robin was opened to share solutions developed. The motion initiated with the delegate of Poland who promoted the idea to educate children about diverse ethnicity to further support refugee children's rights and avoid discrimination. Then the delegates of countries such as Mexico and Syria continued development of programs that promote the help of refugee children with their basic necessities and access to education, Mexico insisted in the development of NGOs, a proposal that was mentioned several times in previous sessions. By the hand of this, delegates continued addressing their solutions showing mutual interest in assuring the protection of refugee minors centering in their educational access as well as decreasing discrimination towards their situation.
