INTRODUCTION

The final day started with the dais taking role assistance in alphabetical order. Afterward, the delegate of Haiti proposed a motion for a moderated concourse; however, it did not pass. So the delegate of Iran suggested a motion for an unmoderated concourse for 10 minutes; that did pass. Subsequently, the delegation of the United States proposed a motion for a moderated concourse for 25 minutes, which was approved by the majority of the delegates. During this time, several countries presented their solutions and engaged in constructive dialogue to address the urgent issue of the Haiti hunger crisis.

MODEL DEVELOPMENT

One of the most important interventions from the delegations was the presentation made by China. The solutions that the delegation proposed were: the seismic technology that can be provided by countries such as New Zealand and China, among others; no military interventions; improving the infrastructure of, for example, roads involving transportation; countries close to Haiti, like, for example, Venezuela or Cuba, could help by providing transportation like ships or cars, making it easier for the transport of supplies to Haiti; among other solutions proposed by the delegation. After the 25 minutes of the moderated concourse ended, the delegation of New Zealand suggested an unmoderated concourse, although it did not pass, so the delegation of the Russian Federation suggested a moderated concourse, which did pass, continuing the debate. The intervention that mostly influenced the debate was the intervention of the Russian Federation, which said that the Russian Federation would ensure that the NGOs inside the delegations of Haiti, such as the Red Cross, among others, transport the imports or supplies around the country. The delegation of New Zealand added that it could bring help or resources to improve education in Haiti so that agriculture could improve. Overall, the discussion focused on ways to effectively distribute aid and resources in Haiti to support sustainable development. Both the Russian Federation and New Zealand, among other delegations, highlighted the importance of collaboration and long-term solutions in addressing the country's needs.



CLOSURE

The delegations of Germany and the United Kingdom separated from the alliance that they had with the delegation of the United States since the delegations did not agree with the ideals of the delegations of the United States. After the moderated concourse ended, the delegation of the Arab Republic of Egypt suggested a speaker list so that all the delegations could confirm its point and with which delegations it would be allied. The motion passed; however, the dais gave the delegates 5 minutes of lobby time so that they could determine their position. During the lobby time, delegations engaged in intense discussions to form new alliances and strategies.
