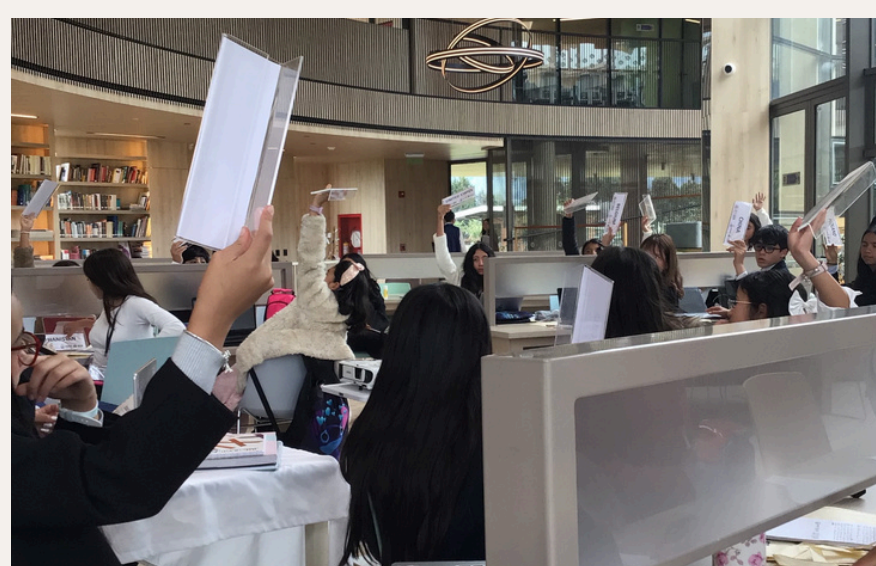


INTRODUCTION

The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) was established in 1950 to address the growing global refugee crisis in order to provide protection and assistance to refugees worldwide. Therefore, the UNHCR committee looks for the protection of the rights of refugees to find asylum and find safe refuge in other countries. In these case, the UNHCR will address two topics that turn around the problematic that child refugees suffer now a days and the challenges they confront to access education.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE MODEL

The committee began with the calling of each delegate and the opening of the first session. Each delegate began reading their opening speech such as Belgium, Canada and Germany, who mention the diverse human rights violation that refugee children's have suffered including the lack of education. During the opening speech most delegates agree that education is a fundamental tool for the future opportunities of these minors proposing the funding of institutions that promote education for refugee children's worldwide. A moderated crocus was opened for 30 minutes by the delegate of United Kingdom , during this space most delegates developed different solutions that were centered in the investment of schools for refugee minors and the development of donations for safer migrate routes. Nevertheles, they were notorious some disagreement between delegates such as Canada and Mexico that didnt saw school investments as an optimal solution. The moderated crocus finally extends 30 minutes and then a speaker list was opened. During this space the Delegate of Germany proposed the use of NGOs as same as the delegate of Mexico with a look to ensure minor migrates a safe migration.



CLOSURE

The solutions that were more highlighted were the proposal of Mexico towards the integration of an NGOs. The delegate of Belgium supported the usage of this NGOs but its implementation in places with more migration rates. On Contrary, the delegation of Poland suggest instead the usage of fundamental organization in order to distribute and produce resources for refugee child's. Finally, the delegate of Spain highlighted the creation of migration routes with the support of Belgium, Germany and Poland with look to improve migrant conditions to transport safely. Other proposal such as implementing refugee camps and developing more accesible community networks were given. With this, another moderated crocus was opened with a look to developed new solutions towards educational accessibility for refugee children.
